Registration will close at midnight on Sunday 28th January 2024. No entries can be accepted after that time.

Payment of entry fees will be by debit or credit card over the Registration System. Please note that entries are only pending, and will not be fully registered, until payment has been made.

Once entries are closed, a running order and event protocol will be issued to all federations in advance of the competition.

Once entry is confirmed, no refunds will be given.

Insurance: It is the responsibility of all Coaches to ensure that their athletes have adequate insurance in place for this event. Athletes and their coaches enter in the full knowledge that Karate competition is an assumed risk activity.

Competition Categories: Please see the attached category list. Competitors are permitted to enter all Kata/Kumite Categories that their age permits. Seniors cannot compete in veterans, categories. In Kumite, competitors can enter both Ippon and Sanbon categories in this event only.

Coaches: When completing the entry, please ensure you list all coaches. Only coaches, who are preregistered, and athletes will be allowed on the competition area. Once entry is confirmed, no refunds will be given.



Event Rules' Amendments

The rules of the event will be World Union of Karate-Do Federations (WUKF) Competition rules: www.wukf-karate.org/wukf-rules/

The following amendments will apply:

Protections:

 to prevent cross infection, Competitors must bring their own protection.

Chest Protection

 Compulsory in all females of all ages.
 Body Armour / Chest protection is allowed.

• Groin Guard: - Compulsory in all Male kumite categories (Ippon, Nihon and Sanbon).

• **Head Guard with visor**: - allowed in Children's Nihon Kumite (Aged 6 – 7 years and must wear a

Gum Shield if they do not use a head guard with a visor).

• Head Guard with visor: - Compulsory for Children Nihon Kumite 8 – 12 years.

Gum Guard: - Compulsory in Sanbon and Ippon Kumite and is allowed in Nihon Kumite

if Children aged 6 – 7 years do not wear a head guard with a visor.

• Shobu Ippon and Shobu Sanbon Kumite: Juniors and Seniors are allowed to compete in both Shobu Ippon and in Shobu Sanbon.

• Mitts: Must be White or Red.

• **Footpads** Allowed in 6 – 7 years Nihon Kumite.

• Footpads: Compulsory in 8 – 12 years Nihon Kumite and in all Sanbon Kumite.

• Shin Protectors: Allowed in Nihon and Sanbon Kumite.

• Gum Shields: Any colour except red

• Belts allowed: Kata - own belt of grade.

Kumite - Red or White belt.

Kata Categories:

a) Children Kata: Athletes in the 9th - 7th Kyu categories can only perform Shitei Kata from

the WUKF list of Kata. Sentei and Tokui Kata will not be allowed. However, they

can repeat a kata.

b) Children Kata: Athletes in the 6^{th} - Dan categories can perform Shitei or Sentei Kata from the WUKF

list of Kata.

c) All Kata Teams must consist of 3 Athletes.

d) Veterans cannot compete in Senior Individual Kata events.

e) Final Round - Maximum of 6 Athletes.

Kumite Categories:

- Children Nihon Rotation teams will be 3 Athletes, and the first team to reach an advantage of 4 wazaris or equivalent, will win.
- In Individual Nihon Kumite categories, in Tie situations, Hantei will be called, and the Referee Panel must decide Aka or Shiro no kachi. Hikiwake cannot be given.
- For Mini-Cadets, Cadets, Seniors and Veterans, all Kumite Team events will be rotation and consist of 3 Athletes. WUKF Rules will apply.
- Additional amendments may be made by the WUKFI organising committee if required.

Event Issues:

- Coaches: Must be properly dressed in their federation Tracksuit and must know the WUKF Rules and be respectful to all Officials. To clarify any Rules issues, there will be a brief Coaches meeting at 08.45am on the morning of the event.
- The badges of other world karate bodies are not allowed on the GI (Top and Trousers).
- No competitor will be allowed to step up categories; the only exception to this rule is in Team Kata where only 1 can competitor from a lower category can step up.

Kata Categories: Medals for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd Place
 Kumite Categories: Medals for 1st, 2nd, and Joint 3rd Place
